- Policy:**
1. **THAT** Council permit Dog Obedience Training Schools and each application be considered on its merits.
  2. **THAT** under Clause 8 subsection (4) of the Dog Act 1966 the Council declares that the following described public place be designated as a "Dog Exercise Area" where it shall not be necessary for a dog to be restrained on a chain, cord or a leash conditional upon every such dog being accompanied by some competent person.

## **DESIGNATED PUBLIC PLACE**

That area of open land located at the southern end of Glamis Street, Kingsgrove and generally bounded as follows:

to the north the southern boundary of dwelling house No 108 Armitree Street, the southern boundary of dwelling houses No's 96 and 99 Glamis Street.

to the east:the rear boundaries of vacant allotments on the eastern side of Glamis Street.

to the south:Wolli Creek.

to the west:The eastern alignment of Armitree Street between 108 Armitree Street and Wolli Creek –

provided that all public land within ten metres of any occupied residential land is excluded from the designated exercise area.
